What We Provide


Most churches today lack the staff and resources to conduct quality retreats themselves. Footsteps provides well crafted Renewal Weekends, staffed by 20 volunteers (including 2 clergy). These Weekends touch the hearts of participants and inspires them to be more active in their home church.

The benefits of a regular retreat weekend fade quickly. In Footsteps, we don't "love them & leave them," but rather provide opportunities each month that reinforce the lessons learned to make a lasting impact in the lives of those who attend.



Why It's Important

You can answer that question yourself. Church membership is declining, and lay leaders are getting older. Now, more than ever, pastors and church ministries need new people to step up into service and lay leadership who are energized and motivated to live out God's love in a hurting world.



How Do We Equip Leaders?

The Renewal Weekends are essentially a refresher course in basic Christianity. Most of the talks are given by lay people. Participants' hearts are transformed as they listen to people, just like themselves, speak about their personal faith walk and challenges that they have had to overcome. Each follower of Jesus has a unique calling. Footsteps enables them to explore their calling and focus on new ways to offer their gifts in ministry to others in their churches and communities.

Weekend Snapshot

Footsteps Weekends are lay-led, with the support of two clergy who provide spiritual direction. Weekends are a blend of structure and joyous spontaneity, surrounded by love. Days start and end with chapel services designed to worship God and challenge participants at the same time.

Participants experience the Weekend in a small group of 5-6 people at a table where they will listen to a dozen inspirational talks and then share their response within the small group. By providing a safe and loving environment, people often share at a deeper level than they have ever shared before. The small group bond is further strengthened during two prayer chapels with their tablemates. These are times of prolonged prayer solely within the small group where participants raise up prayers of thanksgiving, prayers for themselves, and prayers for each other. This can be truly life changing as they talk with God in such an intimate way together.

WEEKEND TALKS

Each talks touches on an aspect of our Christian walk with an opportunity for the speaker to share their own story.

The subjects are that of basic Christianity. The clergy speak about God's Grace, the Holy Spirit, our loving God and how to share your faith with others. Some of the lay talks include Your Christian Walk, the Church, Christian Action, Christian Leadership and how love is the #1 Thing behind every Christian act. We are all used to hearing clergy speak about these subjects, but it is inspiring for the listener to hear lay people speak about their faith walk in such a meaningful way.
